

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. USBC rules and regulations will govern the tournament. Entries are restricted to areas within the Great Salt Lake USBC jurisdiction.
2. All Participants must be a current 2009/2010 Great Salt Lake USBC Youth members. This tournament is USBC Certified.
3. Each entrant will use their highest league average based on a minimum of nine (9) games as of December 31, 2009. Entrants without an average may **submit** a certified nine (9) game league average by tournament opening time. Entrants without a minimum number of games must enter with a 220 scratch average. For a Sport bowling league averages rule 202b will apply.
 - A. It is and will be each bowler's **RESPONSIBILITY** to verify the accuracy of his or her own submitted average.
 - B. It is also each bowler's responsibility to **CHECK** in **30 minutes before they're given squad time and have their USBC card with them.**
4. **IF AN ENTRANT BOWLS SINGLES THEY MUST BOWL DOUBLES AND VICE VERSA.**
Six (6) consecutive games will be bowled with singles first and doubles immediately following.
5. USBC Youth average as of December 31, 2009 will determine divisions. Division strengths are as follows:

6. Mixed teams and doubles as to age, sex and average are allowed.
7. Entries must be completely filled out and averages verified. **Include a copy of all league average sheets as of December 31, 2009.**
8. Each event will be handicapped 100% of a 220 base.
9. Entry fee is \$13.00 per event.

10. Award fees will be returned 100% with one (1) award for each seven (7) entries. Awards will be based upon number of entries received in each division. First place scratch and handicap awards in each division are guaranteed. A bowler may elect to receive a plaque/trophy or the value of such in the form of a scholarship. One or the other but not both.
11. Money must accompany all entries for each event. **Make checks payable to GSLBA.**
No entry money will returned. All returned checks will be charged an additional \$20.00.
12. A **bowler** may enter **Singles & Doubles only once (1)** but may **enter up to three (3)** teams as long as they **do not** consist of more than **two (2)** of the same members. **SCORES FOR THE FIRST TEAM EVENT BOWLED WILL COUNT TOWARDS THE ALL EVENTS.**
13. All bowlers will bowl three (3) games in each event.
14. ****Proper attire is to be worn!** Collared, USBC Youth or League shirts are recommended. (NO HATS, NO SHORTS OR Tattered (Torn) Jeans, No Inappropriate Logos on T-Shirts, NO Low Riding Pants, NO Tank Tops, Midriffs or Low Cut Tops or Sleeveless Shirts). **Any decisions on attire will be at the discretion of the tournament director/committee.**
15. A scholarship (amount to be determined) will be awarded for an 800 series or a 300 game. This scholarship is in addition to any other scholarship received during the tournament.

A Junior Gold Qualifying Tournament will be held during this tournament.

An additional fee of \$25.00 will be required to participate (must be paid prior to bowling Singles/Doubles event)
A Junior Gold Membership must be current; otherwise a membership must be purchased before the event is bowled.

Two Junior Gold spots will be awarded as follows:

1 Boy & 1 Girl (based on 4 entries each sex) highest scratch score for 6 games in Singles & Doubles will be used.

If four girls do not compete their scores will be listed with the boys and the two (2) spots will be awarded to the top two (2) qualifiers.
