# TOURNAMENT RULES

1. USBC rules and regulations will govern the tournament. Entries are restricted to areas within the Great Salt Lake USBC jurisdiction.
2. All participants must be a current 2011/2012 Great Salt Lake USBC Youth members. This tournament is USBC Certified.
3. **(REMEMBER)** Averages. Bowlers will use their high book average of 21 games (high school bowlers 9 games) or more for the 2010-2011 season (winter). If no 2010-2011 season average, then the bowler will use their high summer 2011 average of 12 games or more. If the bowler has neither of the above, then the bowler will use their highest current sanctioned average, for a minimum of 9 games, as of October 1, 2011. Entrants without an average may **submit** a certified nine (9) game league average by tournament opening time. Entrants without a minimum number of games must enter with a 220 scratch average. For a Sport bowling league averages rule 202b will apply.
  - A. It is and will be each bowler's **RESPONSIBILITY** to verify the accuracy of his or her own submitted average. Incorrect averages may be subject to disqualification.
  - B. It is also each bowler's responsibility to **CHECK in 30 minutes before they're given squad time and have their USBC card with them.**

4. **IF AN ENTRANT BOWLS SINGLES THEY MUST BOWL DOUBLES AND VICE VERSA.**  
Six (6) consecutive games will be bowled with singles first and doubles immediately following.

5. Divisions. USBC youth tournament entering average will determine divisions. Division strengths are as follows:

6. Mixed teams and doubles as to age, sex and average are allowed. All bowlers will bowl three (3) games in each event
7. Entries must be completely filled out and averages verified. **If you do not have a book average, include a copy of the league average sheets as of October 1, 2011.**
8. Handicap. Each event will be handicapped 100% of a 220 base.
9. Entry fee. Entry Fee is \$15.00 per event.      Bowling \$ 8.25    Expenses \$ .75    Awards Scholarships \$6.00      All Events \$1.00 (optional)  
Plus \$1.00 All Events
10. All awards/scholarships will be determined with handicap taking precedence over scratch scores.
11. Scholarship. Five different scholarships will be awarded as follows:
 

12 and above – 1 male 1 female; All Events; handicap & scratch	12 and above – 1 male 1 female; High Game & High Series; handicap & scratch
11 and under – 1 male 1 female; All Events; handicap & scratch	11 and under – 1 male 1 female; High Game & High Series; handicap & scratch

 Each divisions 1<sup>st</sup> place OVERALL handicap winner for team, doubles, & singles  
 \*\*(NOTE: This last scholarship is given to the overall handicap winner whether they received both the scratch and handicap award in their specific event)
12. Trophies/ Awards. Can receive a trophy or the value of the trophy in the form of a scholarship; one or the other but not both.
  - Award fees will be returned 100% with one (1) award for each seven (7) entries with first place with handicap and scratch in each division being guaranteed.
  - Awards will be based upon number of entries received in each division.

13. **Dress Code. \*\*Proper attire is to be worn! Collared, USBC Youth or League shirts are recommended. NO HATS, NO SHORTS OR tattered (torn) jeans, NO inappropriate logos, NO low riding pants, NO tank tops, midriffs or low cut tops or sleeveless shirts. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED.**

14. Only assigned tournament bowlers and tournament officials will be permitted in the bowling area during competition (including the buffer).

15. No alcohol consumption during the youth tournament within any of the assigned bowling lanes (including the buffer).

16. Any decisions on attire will be at the discretion of the tournament director/committee.
