TOOELE COUNTY USBC YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. This tournament is certified by the United State Bowling Congress (**#04683**) and shall be governed by USBC rules.

2. Competition will take place at All Star Lanes, 1111 N. 200 W., Tooele, UT 84074 (801-572-1122). Tournament will be held on December 2nd, 2017 at 10:00 am.

3. Entry closing date is Sunday, November 12, 2017. Tournament entry form containing qualifiers' name, address, phone number, date of birth, and bowling center in which the entry is being submitted from must be postmarked and submitted by Monday, November 13, 2017 to the tournament director. Please make sure this information is complete. If the entry is not complete the entry will be sent back.

4. This is a singles only competition. Divisions are based on the participant's age. **Athletes must compete in their proper age division in all levels of competition. All competition is HANDICAP except Junior Gold Qualifiers and shall be conducted in the following divisions:**

U12 GIRLS & U12 BOYS - Bowlers whose birthdate is 8/1/2005 or later

U15 GIRLS & U15 BOYS - Bowlers whose birthdate is 8/1/2002 thru 7/31/2005

U20 GIRLS & U20 BOYS - Bowlers whose birthdate is 8/1/1997 thru 7/31/2002

5. AVERAGE & HANDICAP: Handicap will be 100% of the difference between the individual's average and 210. Bowlers will use their high book average of 12 games or more for the 2016-2017 season. If no book average exists, the bowler will use their highest current sanctioned average, for a minimum of 12 games, as of **November 1, 2017**. If using current average, bowlers will need to submit average verification sheet. All other bowlers will bowl scratch. For all Sport Bowling league averages, Rule 205 will apply.

6. Divisions U12, U15 and U20 will bowl 3 games of qualifying on **Saturday 12/02/2017**. A tie for first place after the qualifying competition will be broken by a one-game roll-off on a pair of lanes determined by the tournament director. Should a tie still exist, a ninth and 10th frame roll-off shall be used to break the tie.

7. Entry fee is:

Awards and scholarship fee shall be returned 100% to the bowlers. All scholarship monies will be held in SMART (acct #13282). All checks returned by banks, credit unions etc. will be charged \$30 plus bank fees.

8. Plaques will be awarded to the handicap winner of each division. Scholarships will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each division based on handicap. Finalists will receive scholarships based on entries of scholarship fees collected for each division.

9. Optional Junior Gold Qualifier– A Junior Gold Qualifier for each division will be available for an additional \$15 to all participants in this tournament provided the following provision has been met. 1) The bowler must be a Junior Gold Member. There is NO additional bowling for the optional Junior Gold divisions. Scratch scores bowled during their regular event will be used. Bowlers will remain in the same division as the handicap competition. All funds collected will be returned in the form of scholarships and entry in to Junior Gold Finals.

10. A minimum of four (4) Junior Gold members must participate for each division. If there are not four members for a division, mixed competition will occur. The tournament committee will have final decision on which divisions will be combined if needed.

11. Competitors shall be allowed 10 minutes of practice time prior to competition.

12. Bowlers arriving late shall begin play and score shall count beginning with the frame being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Frames may not be made-up. A bowler not present to bowl when it's their turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.

13. Dress attire must be neat, clean and proper fitting. A collared shirt, a mock tee or youth league shirt is required, and slacks are highly recommended but long pants of some type is required as suitable attire. **NO HATS, SHORTS, SKIRTS** and no exposed under garments or midriffs will be allowed. No smoking by guests or athletes and no alcohol is to be consumed on the concourse during competition. Bowlers may not use or wear any electronic device while on the approach or during their turns of bowling. No device shall be audible to any other player or official, or interfere with any other participant. Cell phones and pagers must be turned off and must not be used while bowling in the tournament.

14. No substitutes will be permitted.

15. Only bowlers and tournament officials shall be permitted in the settee area.

16. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than the start of the next game or 30 minutes after the completion of the competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours of the infraction. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.

17. The first-place winner in each division of the Junior Gold Qualifier will advance to the 2017 Junior Gold Championships in Dallas, TX. They must be USBC Junior Gold members to advance to the Junior Gold Championships. These athletes will compete for additional scholarships available to all athletes at the championships, as well as other prizes and awards. All U.S. citizens are vying for a spot on USBC Junior Team USA 2017 to represent the United States in national and international competition.

18. Eligible advancers must agree to bowl in the Junior Gold Championships, or, failing to do so, agree to waive all rights. Replacements will be selected based on the order of finish in their division at the state level. Replacements will incur all costs associated with changing the airline ticket, if applicable. If the eligible advancer decides not to attend the Junior Gold Championships, any stipends offered will be forfeited however any scholarships earned at the tournament level will be retained.

19. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by Tournament Committee. The Tooele County USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.
