Tournament Rules:

- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all Great Salt Lake Youth and Adult USBC members holding a current membership card and is in good standing with the GSLBA and USBC. One adult and one youth per team.
- DIVISIONS:** This is a handicap tournament. Division A is 370 and above; Division B is 301 to 369; Division C is 300 and below.
- AVERAGES:** Bowlers will use their highest 2019-2020 USBC certified (book) average based. If bowlers do not have a 2019-2020 certified average then the previous seasons average will be used (2018-2019). If no certified (book) average then a current average of 9 games as of the date of the tournament will be used or will use average established during 2019-2020 summer league. A league standing sheet dated the week of 9/20-9/27 needs to be provided the day of the tournament if a current average is being used. Handicap is based on 90% of 230. For certified sport bowling league average rule 202b will apply. If the current average is 10 pins over certified (book) average, the rerate rule applies (USBC Rule 319a.2)
- It is each bowler's responsibility to verify his/her own submitted average.
 - It is each bowler's responsibility to check in 30 minutes before their given squad.
- VERIFICATION:** It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average on the day of the event.
- ENTRY FEES:** **\$15.00 per person:** Bowling - \$7.50, Expenses - \$0.50, Scholarship/Award Fees -\$7.00
No entry fee will be refunded. Returned checks will be charged an additional \$25.00 + bank charges. For walk ins, Credit Cards are accepted and will be charged a \$2.00 processing fee. You may enter more than once but with a different partner if lanes are available.
- BOWLERS AREA:** Only participants & tournament officials are permitted in the bowling area. Food & drink will be permitted outside the bowling area (behind area on tables or counters). **CELL PHONES AND ANY ELECTRONIC DEVICES MUST BE TURNED OFF DURING COMPETITION.**
- DRESS CODE:** The Dress Code Will Be Strictly Enforced. All participants (men, women & youth) may wear casual slacks, trousers, jeans, skorts and shorts. Shorts and skorts length must go beyond the fingertips when your arms are at rest along your sides. Participants must wear a shirt with sleeves; preferably a collared shirt.
Unacceptable attire includes, but not limited to:
- Hats (except for medical reasons)
 - Tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, etc., workout attire, lounge pants, bib overalls, jeans that are torn (skin showing), not clean or in poor condition.
 - Attire with inappropriate, questionable, or offensive language or graphics.
- ELECTRONIC DEVICES:** Cell phones and any Electronic Device must be turned off during competition.
- SCHOLARSHIPS**
- AWARDS:** Scholarships and Awards will be given out with a ratio of 1 in 6. High Series & High Game Scratch & Handicap will be awarded (youth 1 boy and 1 girl). All scholarships will be sent to SMART Acct #10645.
- JUNIOR GOLD**
- BASIC RULES:** Bowlers are permitted to enter once per qualifying event. Re-entries are not permitted. Bowlers must be Junior Gold members PRIOR to the start of qualifying.
- Bowlers may sign up for membership on site before qualifying starts.
 - Pepsi Championship qualifiers must purchase a Junior Gold membership prior to competing in the Junior Gold Championship tournament.

All disputes will be settled by the GSLBA Youth Committee. All protests and appeals must be in accordance with USBC Rule 329. Anything not covered in these rules will be governed by the USBC rule/play book.
