## 2020 WOMEN'S CITY TOURNAMENT INFORMATION & RULES

This tournament shall be conducted in accordance with the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) rules and regulations in addition to rules adopted by the Great Salt Lake Bowling Association (GSLBA). The GSLBA has the authority to make decisions regarding anything not covered by these rules.

1. **Eligibility/Age:** The "WOMEN'S" tournament is for female GSLBA members age 18 years and older at the time of participation. Non-members who do not have a USBC card may purchase a membership for \$24.00. Those with a USBC membership but not from the GSLBA must pay \$9.00 if living within the state of Utah for local dues, or \$11.00 if living outside the state of Utah for local and state association dues.
2. **Average Requirements:** Entrants shall use their composite average of all USBC leagues based on 12 games or more for the 2019-2020 bowling season **as published on bowl.com**. If no previous season composite average, entrant will use a current season average in a USBC certified league based on 12 games or more. Entrants must provide current average verification from their league secretary at time of check-in. A 230 will be assigned to any female entrant wishing to bowl who does not have a verifiable average.
3. **PROFESSIONAL BOWLERS**  
For the purpose of participation in the GSLBA Women's Tournament, PROFESSIONAL BOWLERS are defined as:
  - a. Any member having applied for membership in ANY professional bowling organization during the calendar year (Jan. 1 – Dec 31, 2020) preceding the event, and up through their dates of their competition in 2020. All professional bowlers of national PBA/PWBA events will be eligible to compete in the GSLBA Women's Tournament, but they must follow these guidelines:
  - b. Not more than ONE bowler identified as professionals (see description of professional above) per four-person team, under the age of 60, who has won a PWBA national event (regardless of professional status at the time of the event); or won the USBC Queens; or U.S. Women's Open from 2003-2020. AND
  - c. Not more than ONE bowler identified as a professional (see description of professional above) per doubles team.
  - d. Each such player shall be eligible to enter SINGLES and ALL-EVENTS
  - e. Professionals are eligible for daily brackets products. They also are eligible for any age-based products for which they qualify.
4. **Handicap:** Handicap for the "WOMEN'S" tournament is 100% of 230.
5. **Entry Fee:**
  - a. Entry fee is \$30.00 per event per bowler. All-Events HDCP fee (optional) is \$10.00 per bowler. All-Events Scratch fee (optional) is \$10.00 per bowler. Senior All-Events HDCP fee (optional) \$10.00 per bowler. Senior All-Events Scratch fee (optional) \$10.00 per bowler.
  - b. Entries for all-events will be accepted any time prior to the start of practice before the bowler's **first** event.
  - c. Breakdown-team, doubles, & singles per bowler per event-\$17.25 prize fund, \$8.25 lineage, \$4.50 expenses. \$1.00 of tournament expenses will be designated to the Hall of Fame (\$0.50) and BVL (\$0.50).
  - d. Breakdown-All-Events Handicap & Scratch and Senior All-Events Handicap & Scratch -100% to prize fund for each class.
  - e. NO refunds (USBC rule 314) **\$35.00 FEE WILL BE ASSESSED FOR ALL RETURNED ITEMS**
6. **Credit Card Service Fee:** Credit or debit cards will be accepted as payment. A \$2.00 service fee will be charged with each entry transaction.
7. **Participation:** This is a Certified USBC competition and will consist of two events: Team, Doubles & Singles. An individual may bowl **multiple** team events as long as at least 2 players in the line-up are different. **\*\*Doubles event may be bowled multiple times with different partners as schedule permits. Multiple Doubles event reserved on Saturday at 3:00 PM ONLY.** Bowlers may cash more than once with multiple partners. Singles may only be bowled once. Singles & Doubles will be one event. **Walk-ins are allowed as schedule permits based on lane availability and must arrive at least (45) minutes before squad start time.**
8. **Check-In:** Entrants are required to check in thirty (30) minutes prior to squad time.
9. **Substitutes:** Substitutes are allowed and must be reported to the tournament manager/official at least 30 minutes prior to the squad start. In case of disability after a game has started a substitute shall be allowed if one is available. If no substitute is available only the actual score of frames bowled shall count. A substitute will not be required or expected to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee paid and is not expected nor required to give the original entrant any prize money or award the substitute may win.
10. **Reschedule:** Team, Singles & Doubles – Will be allowed only if room is available on another squad time/or day. The request must be made to the GSLBA tournament office as soon as possible but no later than 30 minutes prior to the assigned squad start. Doubles event only; the doubles partner can request to be rescheduled only if a substitute cannot be found 5 minutes prior to the squad start time and only if there is room to move to another squad time and/or day. NO refunds if the GSLBA or the bowler(s) are unable to reschedule to a later squad time/date (see rule #5e).
11. **Late or Tardy:** Bowlers arriving after the start of any of their scheduled events will receive zeros for frames missed. The option of requesting a reschedule may or may not be granted based on tournament schedule and lane availability (see rule #10).
12. **Schedule:** Entries will be processed in the order received and availability. The schedule will not be changed except for an emergency (see rule #10). Lane assignments and times will be completed by the tournament committee. Any Team, Doubles, or Single event participants wishing to be scheduled at the same time and bowl on adjacent/same lanes will need to submit their entries together in the same envelope with a written request. Online entry will be provided an information box to enter request. If no request is received lanes assignments will be at the discretion of the tournament managers and committee.
13. **Line-Up:** The line-up will be set as submitted on the entry form for each event.
14. **Lane Conditioning:** Lane conditioning will be done before each squad. Tournament oil pattern will be determined by GSLBA.
15. **Awards:** 100% of all prize monies will be returned. Prize checks will be issued within Thirty (30) days after the close of the tournament. Prize checks will be mailed or hand delivered to the individual participant.
16. **Prize Ratio:** Ratio will be based on tournament participation and may be adjusted at the Tournament Director's discretion based on the total number of entries. In the event of first place ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be divided. In the event of last place ties, extra money will be added.
17. **Protest:** Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed **in writing** to the tournament manager within 72 hours of tournament close. Errors in scoring must be reported at the time the error is entered. Unexpected situations will be handled by the tournament management.
18. **Dress Code:** The Dress Code Will Be Strictly Enforced. All participants may wear casual slacks, trousers, jeans skorts and shorts, Shorts must fall within 2 inches of the knee. Participants must wear a shirt with sleeves; preferably a collared shirt. Unacceptable attire includes, but not limited to:
  - Tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, etc., workout attire, lounge pants, bib overalls, jeans that are torn (skin showing), not clean or in poor condition.
  - Attire with inappropriate questionable, or offensive language or graphics.Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament management or designee. Tournament management or designee decisions will be final. **There are NO exceptions.**
19. **Conduct:** Participants and observers shall conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times during the tournament. Unsportsmanlike behavior=will not be tolerated on the lanes or inside the tournament venue. Individuals are subject to ejection for engaging in improper tactics or conduct including, but not limited to, physical or verbal abuse toward other persons. Tournament officials have the right to disqualify any participants and observers who conduct is derogatory or detrimental to the best interests of the tournament. Please be ready to bowl when it is your turn, observing one-lane courtesy. No unreasonable delay in the progress of any game is permitted (USBC Rule 11)
20. **Liability:** The entrants whose names appear thereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the Great Salt Lake Bowling Association (GSLBA), its officers or agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fee, if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies of cause relating thereto or resulting there from, fire, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond its control.

**Entry Submission Dates:** Entry received by Midnight **November 8, 2020** will have squad availability. Entries received after this date will be assigned based on space availability and squad size.
