## 62ND ANNUAL GSLBA YOUTH TOURNAMENT INFORMATION & RULES

Tournament shall be conducted in accordance with the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) rules and regulations in addition to rules adopted by the Great Salt Lake USBC (GSLUSBC). Tournament Director/Officials have final decisions regarding anything not covered by these rules.

1. **Eligibility/Age:** The "YOUTH" tournament is open to all USBC youth members with a current 2025-2026 USBC Youth membership.
2. **Average Requirements:** The average to be used will be determined in the following manner:
  - a. Bowlers will use their composite average from the 24/25 season with a combined games total of all leagues bowled equal to or greater than 12 for the season as listed on bowl.com. If no 24/25 average, then a current league sheet with a minimum of 9 games may be used. If the bowler has no established average prior to the tournament, youth 12 years and under will enter with a 140 average – youth 13 years and older will enter with a 200 average. **Sport/Challenge league averages will be converted for competition. Rule 201a, b, & c, will apply**
  - b. It is the responsibility of each bowler to verify their average listed on the scoresheet. Bowlers who do not report an incorrect average may be subject to disqualification.
  - c. If an average is incorrect, the bowler must immediately bring this to the attention of the tournament director for correction prior to the completion of the first game in any event.
3. **Check In:** Preregistered/prepaid entrants are requested to check in 45 minutes before squad starting time – **Walk-ins should register and check in 1 hour prior to squad starting time.**
4. **Credit Card Payments:** Credit or debit cards will be accepted for payment.
5. **Participation:** Mixed teams and doubles as to age, sex and average are allowed. All bowlers will bowl three (3) games in each event. Bowlers may enter the team event more than once but not more than two (2) members can be the same on any team. Bowlers may enter doubles more than once but must change partners. Singles will be allowed to be bowled only once. The score of the FIRST TEAM, FIRST DOUBLES, and SINGLES events bowled will count for All Events if the \$5.00 All Events scratch and/or \$5.00 All Events Handicap fee has been paid prior to first event. **THE DIVISION YOU ENTER IN SINGLES WILL BE THE DIVISION YOU WILL BE IN FOR ALL EVENTS.**

10. **Schedule:** Entries will be processed in the order received and scheduled based on availability. The schedule will not be changed except for an emergency. Lane assignments and times will be completed by the tournament manager(s). All lane assignments will be at the discretion of the tournament managers.
11. **Line-Up:** The line-up will be set as submitted on the entry form for each event.
12. **Lane Conditioning:** Lane conditioning will be done before each squad. Tournament oil pattern will be determined by the GSLBA leadership and bowling center manager.
13. **Awards:** 100% of all scholarship monies collected will be returned based upon number of entries received in each division. All Tournament funded Scholarships will be determined with handicap scores taking precedence over scratch scores. **Paid entry into All Events is not required.**
14. **Added Scholarship funds and Additional Scholarships:** The Great Salt Lake USBC will add at least \$5 per entry, per event into the scholarship funds. In addition, the GSLBA will award (16) additional scholarships\*. These 16 scholarships **are not** part of the scholarship funds generated by the Youth tournament and come specifically from GSLBA Unassigned funds. **To be eligible for these specific additional scholarships you must be a member of the Great Salt Lake USBC AND a current season Youth League member actively bowling on a league serviced and held within the jurisdiction of the GSLBA Bowling Association (league subs do not qualify as active members).** All Additional Scholarships will be determined with handicap scores taking precedence over scratch scores. (GSLBA reserves the right to increase or adjust the amount of unassigned funds used for the benefit of the youth bowlers)
15. **Dress Code:** All bowlers may wear casual slacks, trousers, jeans, skorts and shorts. Boys' shorts must extend to within 3 inches of the knee. Girls' shorts/skorts must extend at least 2 inches beyond the fingertips when arms are naturally resting at their sides. Gym/athletic shorts are not allowed. All bowlers are required to wear shirts with sleeves. Collared or Mock Collared shirts are preferred. Unacceptable attire includes, but not limited to:
  - Tank tops, shirts without sleeves or cut out sleeves, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, etc., leggings, workout attire, lounge pants, bib overalls, gym/athletic clothing, jeans that are torn, worn with or without skin showing, or in poor condition. Any clothing that is not clean.
  - Hats (except for documented medical reasons)
  - Attire with inappropriate, questionable, or offensive language or graphics.
  - The GSLBA and tournament management will have final decisions on all dress code related issues and reserves the right to request/require any bowler to change any article of clothing determined not appropriate for tournament participation.
  - If a bowler refuses to change once requested, bowler will be disqualified and forfeit entry fee for the event(s) of occurrence.
  - **There are NO exceptions.**
16. **Conduct:** Bowlers are responsible for their conduct. Tournament officials have the right to disqualify any bowler whose conduct is derogatory or detrimental to the best interests of the tournament. No unreasonable delay in the progress of any game is permitted. (USBC rule 11) Absolutely NO alcohol consumption, tobacco use or vaping during the youth tournament within any of the assigned lanes (including the buffer). Only assigned bowlers and tournament officials will be permitted in the bowling area during competition.
17. **Electronic Devices:** Electronic devices will be allowed in the settee area provided they do not cause delay of play. If it is found to be causing delay, the bowler will be asked to put the electronics away. This will be announced at the beginning of the squad. No further warning will be given.
18. **Liability:** The entrants whose names appear thereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the Great Salt Lake Bowling Association (GSLBA), its officers or agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fee, if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies of cause relating thereto or resulting there from, fire, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond its control.
19. **Entry Submission Dates:** Online entry close **Midnight February 21, 2026.** Paper entry close **postmark February 26, 2026.** Entries received after these dates will be assigned based on space availability and squad size. **Walk-ins must arrive at least 1 hour before squad start time.**
20. **Cross Over Doubles:** This will be an option for all doubles squads. The cost is \$5 per bowler. Sign up for this prior to the start of the squad.

\*Additional Scholarships Available (see rule #14): Bowlers may receive one of the following awards.

- \$ 600.00 Paul Pullman Scholarship Award – All Events Handicap & Scratch – 1 Boy, 1 Girl – 13 & Above (total of 4) – Total Additional = \$2,400.00
- \$ 350.00 Elma Barnes Scholarship Award – All Events Handicap & Scratch – 1 Boy, 1 Girl – 12 & Under (total of 4) – Total Additional = \$1,400.00
- \$ 250.00 Tournament High Game & High Series – Handicap & Scratch – 1 Boy, 1 Girl – 13 & Above and 12 & Under (total of 8) – Total Additional = \$2,000.00

All rules for the 2026 Youth Tournament are subject to change due to concerns with community health, weather or other disaster. This includes, but is not limited to, tournament dates, locations, format(s), operations and bowler services. All protests and appeals must be in accordance with USBC Rule 329. Anything not covered within the tournament rules will be governed by tournament management, GSLBA and USBC national playing rules.
