57TH ANNUAL CITY YOUTH TOURNAMENT INFORMATION & RULES

Tournament shall be conducted in accordance with the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) rules and regulations in addition to rules adopted by the Great Salt Lake USBC (GSLUSBC). Tournament Director/Officials have final decisions regarding anything not covered by these rules.


- Eligibility/Age:** The "YOUTH" tournament is open to all USBC youth members with a current 2020-2021 USBC Youth membership.
- Average Requirements:** The average to be used will be determined in the following manner:
 - Bowlers will use their composite average with a minimum of 21 games combined, as reported on bowl.com for the 2019-2020 season. Challenge and/or sport league averages will be converted and if 10 or more pins higher than the bowl.com composite average then the highest of either the highest challenge or sport league average will be used as the entering average.
 - Bowlers without an average **INCLUDING NEW HIGH SCHOOL LEAGUE BOWLERS** may submit a certified (9) game league average by tournament opening time.
 - Entrants without a minimum number of games must enter with a 205-scratch average.
 - For a Non-Certified Challenge League and a Sport Bowling League, averages rule 202b will apply.
 - If the current average is 10 pins over the certified average, the rerate rule applies (USBC Rule 319a.2)
 - IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH BOWLER TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF HIS OR HER OWN SUBMITTED AVERAGE.** If an average is wrong, the bowler must immediately bring this to the attention of the tournament director for correction. **If an average is verified by the bowler and found to be wrong, the bowler may be disqualified for each event the average was verified wrong.**

3. **Check In:** Preregistered entrants are requested to check in 30 minutes before squad starting time – **Walk-ins must register and check in 1 hour prior to squad starting time.**

4. **Participation:** Mixed teams and doubles as to age, sex and average are allowed. All bowlers will bowl three (3) games in each event. Bowlers may enter the team event more than once but not more than two (2) members can be the same on any team. Bowlers may enter doubles more than once but must change partners each time. Singles will be allowed to be bowled only once. The score of the FIRST TEAM, FIRST DOUBLES, and SINGLES event bowled will count for All Events if the \$5.00 All Events scratch and/or \$5.00 All Events Handicap fee has been paid prior to first event. **THE DIVISION YOU ENTER IN SINGLES WILL BE THE DIVISION YOU WILL BE IN FOR ALL EVENTS.**

5. **Divisions:**

USBC youth tournament entering average will determine divisions.

6. **Entry:** Entries must be complete and average verified. If no composite average, please include a copy of league average sheet as of June 12, 2021.

7. **Entry Fee/Scholarship:** NO refunds (USBC rule 314) **\$35.00 FEE WILL BE ASSESSED FOR ALL RETURNED ITEMS.**

8. **Handicap:** Each event will be handicapped 100% of a 210 base.

9. **Credit Card:** Credit or debit cards will be accepted as payment.

10. **Schedule:** Entries will be processed in the order received and availability. The schedule will not be changed except for an emergency. Lane assignments and times will be completed by the tournament manager(s). Any Team, Doubles, or Single event participants wishing to be scheduled at the same time and bowl on adjacent/same lanes will need to submit their entries together in the same envelope with a written request. Online entry will be provided an information box to enter request. If no request is received lanes assignments will be at the discretion of the tournament managers.

11. **Line-Up:** The line-up will be set as submitted on the entry form for each event.

12. **Lane Conditioning:** Lane conditioning will be done before each squad. Tournament oil pattern will be determined by GSLUSBC.

13. **Awards:** 100% of all scholarship monies collected will be returned based upon number of entries received in each division. All Tournament funded Scholarships will be determined with handicap scores taking precedence over scratch scores. **Paid entry into All Events is not required.**

14. **Additional Scholarships:** The Great Salt Lake USBC will award (16) additional scholarships. These scholarships **are not** part of the scholarship funds generated by the Youth tournament and come specifically from GSLUSBC funds. To be eligible for these specific additional scholarships you must be a member of the Great Salt Lake USBC and a current season Youth League member actively bowling on a Youth league serviced and held within the jurisdiction of the GSLUSBC Bowling Association. All Additional Scholarships will be determined with handicap scores taking precedence over scratch scores. **Paid entry into All Events is not required.**

15. **Protest:** Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be confirmed **in writing** to the tournament manager within 72 hours of tournament close. Errors in scoring must be reported at the time the error is entered. Unexpected situations will be handled by the tournament management.

16. **Dress Code:** The Dress Code Will Be Strictly Enforced. All participants may wear casual slacks, trousers, jeans, skorts and shorts. Shorts and skorts length must go beyond the fingertips when your arms are at rest along your sides. Participants must wear a shirt with sleeves; preferably a collared shirt. Unacceptable attire includes, but not limited to: Hats (except for medical reasons), tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, etc, workout attire, lounge pants, bib overalls, jeans that are torn (skin showing), not clean or in poor condition. Attire with inappropriate, questionable, or offensive language or graphics. **There are NO exceptions.**

17. **Conduct:** Bowlers are responsible for their conduct. Tournament officials have the right to disqualify any bowler whose conduct is derogatory or detrimental to the best interests of the tournament. No unreasonable delay in the progress of any game is permitted. (USBC rule 11) Absolutely NO alcohol consumption during the youth tournament within any of the assigned lanes (including the buffer). Only assigned bowlers and tournament officials will be permitted in the bowling area during competition (including the buffer).

18. **Electronic Devices:** No electronic devices will be allowed in the settee area except for medical reasons. Cell phones must be turned off during competition.

19. **Liability:** The entrants whose names appear thereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the Great Salt Lake Bowling Association (GSLBA), its officers or agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fee, if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies of cause relating thereto or resulting there from, fire, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond its control.

20. **Entry Submission Dates:** Entry received by Midnight **May 29, 2021** will have preference of squad availability. Entries received after this date will be assigned based on space availability and squad size. **Walk-ins must arrive at least 1 hour before squad start time.**

- \$ 100.00 Tournament High Game & High Series – Handicap & Scratch – 1 Boy, 1 Girl – 12 & Above and 11 & Under (total of 8)



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
