## Tournament Rules:

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all Great Salt Lake Youth and Adult USBC members holding a current membership card and in good standing with the GSLBA and USBC. One adult and one youth per team.

**DIVISIONS:** This is a handicap tournament. Division A - 370 and above; Division B - 301 to 369; Division C - 300 & below.

**AVERAGES:** Bowlers will use their highest 2017-2018 USBC certified average of 9 games or more of all leagues (summer & winter) as posted on bowl.com as of the first day of tournament play. If bowlers do not have a 2017-2018 certified average then the previous seasons average will be used (2016-2017). If no certified average then a current average of 9 games as of the date of the 1<sup>st</sup> squad participant bowls will be used. A league standing sheet dated the week of 9/9/18 -9/22/18 needs to be provided the day of the tournament if a current average is being used. Handicap is based on 90% of 230. For certified sport bowling league average rule 202b will apply. If the current average is 10 pins over certified bowl.com average, the rerate rule applies (USBC Rule 319a.2)

- It is each bowler's responsibility to verify his/her own submitted average.
- It is each bowler's responsibility to check in 30 minutes before their given squad.

**VERIFICATION:** It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average on the day of the event.

**ENTRY FEES:** **\$15.00 per person:** Bowling - \$6.00, Expenses/Trophies - \$1.50, Scholarship - \$7.50 per person. No entry fee will be refunded. Returned checks will be charged an additional \$25.00 + bank charges. Credit Cards are accepted and will be charged a \$2.00 processing fee. You may enter more than once but with a different partner if lanes are available.

**BOWLERS AREA:** Only participants & tournament officials are permitted in the bowling area. Food & drink will be permitted outside the bowling area (behind area on tables or counters). **CELL PHONES AND ANY ELECTRONIC DEVICES MUST BE TURNED OFF DURING COMPETITION.**

**DRESS CODE:** The Dress Code Will Be Strictly Enforced. All participants (men, women & youth) may wear casual slacks, trousers, jeans, skorts and shorts. Shorts and skorts length must go beyond the fingertips when your arms are at rest along your sides. Participants must wear a shirt with sleeves; preferably a collared shirt.

Unacceptable attire includes, but not limited to:

- Hats (except for medical reasons)
- Tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, etc., workout attire, lounge pants, bib overalls, jeans that are torn (skin showing), not clean or in poor condition.
- Attire with inappropriate, questionable, or offensive language or graphics.

**ELECTRONIC DEVICES:**

Cell phones and any Electronic Device must be turned off during competition.

**SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDS:**

Scholarships and Awards will be given out with a ratio of 1 in 6.

High Series & High Game Scratch & Handicap will be awarded (youth 1 boy and 1 girl). All scholarships will be sent to SMART Acct #10645.

**JUNIOR GOLD BASIC RULES:**

Bowlers are permitted to enter once per qualifying event. Re-entries are not permitted. Bowlers must be Junior Gold members **PRIOR** to the start of qualifying.

- Bowlers may sign up for membership on site before qualifying starts.
- Pepsi Championship qualifiers must purchase a Junior Gold membership prior to competing in the Junior Gold Championship tournament.

All disputes will be settled by the GSLBA Board of Directors & Youth Committee. All protests and appeals must be filed **in writing** to the tournament official within 72 hours of infraction. Anything not covered in these rules will be governed by the USBC rules.
