Tournament Rules:

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Great Salt Lake USBC Youth & Adult members with a valid membership in good standing and consists of (1) Adult & (1) Youth member per Doubles team. Those without a valid membership, adult or youth USBC/GSLBA may purchase one on site.

DIVISIONS: This is a handicap tournament. Division A is 355 and above; Division B is 320 to 354; Division C is 319 and below.

AVERAGES: Bowlers will be assigned their composite average from the 20/21 season with a combined games total of all leagues bowled equal to or greater than 12 for the season as listed on bowl.com. If no 20/21 then 19/20 may be used with the same stipulation as for the 20/21 season. If the composite average requirement cannot be met then bowlers will use the highest established average from either the 20/21 or 19/20 season with at least 9 games as reported on bowl.com. If none of the above can be established then a current season 21/22 league average sheet from each/all leagues signed by each leagues secretary and submitted to the GSLBA tournament officials (*what time frame do you want?*) and the highest average with a minimum of 6 games will be used. If none of the above outlined average requirements are met as of August 1, 2021, youth boys & girls 12 years & under will enter with a 140 average, 13 years & over will enter with a 200 average. Adults will enter with a 220 average. - ***Sport/challenge league averages will be converted for competition. Rule 201 a, b & c, Rule 319 a (1b) 3 & 4, Rule 319 d & e will apply.***

AVERAGE

VERIFICATION: It is each bowler's responsibility to verify his/her own submitted average even if submitted by another on their behalf. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average on the day of the event(s) as printed on the scoresheet. Any averages listed/printed on score sheets that are higher than defined in the eligibility rule will remain as listed and if not corrected by the completion of the 1st game. Any averages listed/printed that are lower and not correct by the completion 1st game will be corrected and disqualified from the squad being bowled and may result in disqualification from the tournament.

HANDICAP: All bowlers will use 90% of 230

ENTRY FEES: Fee per Doubles Team - \$40.00 (\$20.00 per bowler) Breakdown – Scholarship/prize fund \$15.00, Lineage \$19.50, Expense \$5.50. ***This tournament is for benefit of the GSLBA youth bowlers with 100% of prize/scholarship fund donated to the youth.*** Returned checks will be charged an additional \$35.00. Multiple entry is allowed with different partners as squad and lane availability permit. No Refunds – USBC Rule 314.

ELECTRONIC

DEVICES: All electronic devices including and not limited to cell phones/ipods/earbuds/headphones must be turned off for all youth bowlers, adults are required to have cell phones on silent. Youth/Adult bowlers are not allowed to have any electronic devices in the bowler's area during competition.

BOWLER'S

AREA: Only participants & tournament officials are permitted in the bowling area. Food & drink will be permitted during competition outside of the bowler's area (food and drink must remain in in the designated spectator's area on tables or counters and not cross into the bowler's area while being consumed) ***All electronic devices of any kind are not allowed in the bowler's area – refer to the above rule – ELECTRONIC DEVICES***

DRESS CODE: All participants may wear casual slacks, trousers, jeans, skorts and shorts. Men/Boys shorts must extent to within 3 inches of the knee, cargo and gym/athletic shorts are not allowed. Women/Girls – shorts/skorts must extend beyond the fingertips when your arms are naturally resting at your sides, skirts and gym/athletic shorts are not allowed. All participants are required to wear a shirt with sleeves, shirts without sleeves or sleeves cut out are not allowed. Collared or Mock Collared shirts are preferred. Unacceptable attire includes, but not limited to:

- Tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, etc., workout attire, lounge pants, bib overalls, gym/athletic clothing, jeans that are torn, worn with or without skin showing, or in poor condition. Any clothing that is not clean
- Hats (except for documented medical reasons)
- Attire with inappropriate, questionable, or offensive language or graphics.
- The GSLBA and tournament management will have final decisions on all dress code related issues and reserves the right to request/require any participant to change any article of clothing determined not appropriate for tournament participation.
- If bowler refuses to change once requested, bowler will be disqualified and forfeit entry fee for the event(s) of occurrence.

SCHOLARSHIPS

AWARDS: Scholarship Prize Fund will be paid out based on number of entries received with a minimum pay out of 1 in 10 for each class of scholarship/adult prize fund. The GSLBA will match the per entry scholarship contribution of \$15.00 to add additional funds to the total scholarship amount collected using unassigned funds held in the GSLBA SMART account # 10645 for each youth bowler participating in the tournament. Additional Special Youth Scholarship awards are available and paid out using unassigned funds held by the GSLBA – Only current active GSLBA youth league members with at least (1) established GSLBA league participation in the 20/21 season with games equal to or greater than 3/4 registered league season qualify. Youth will only be eligible to receive one award in either category with game award assigned first then series award. If the same person is listed in both game/series it will drop to the next eligible youth. Youth who bowl in multiple divisions will only receive the highest game or series award for the division they score the highest in. If a bowler has the highest game/series in multiple divisions, the highest division will take precedence. High Series/Game Handicap & Scratch each division – (1) boy/(1) girl each for (12) of \$100.00 each.

All rules for the 2021/2022 Adult/Youth Tournament are subject to change due to concerns with COVID-19. This includes, but is not limited to, tournament dates, locations, format(s), operations and bowler services. All bowler services shall be conducted electronically whenever possible. Participants will be required to submit a waiver/release prior to completion. Health precautions, such as a temperature check, may be done prior to entry into the bowling center. Masks are recommended for all bowlers and tournament officials. Bowlers and officials may be required to wear a mask. Should a bowler exhibit symptom of COVID-19, any variant, including, but not limited to, a temperature above 100.4 degrees, the proper local health authorities will be notified for potential follow-up and contact tracing. Anyone who has been tested for COVID-19 within 14 days of the first official day of competition must inform tournament management. If the participant is unaware of the test results, he/she may not compete until a negative result has been received and submitted to tournament management.

Any disputes must be brought to the GSLBA tournament officials on site at the time of occurrence and will be settled at that time. All protest and appeals must be in accordance with USBC Rule 329. Anything not covered within the tournament rules will be governed by tournament management and USBC national playing rules.
